

## PERSON-CENTERED MEDICAL HOME PROGRAM HEALTH QUALITY PERFORMANCE MEASURES

### Pediatric Quality Measures

- Well-child visits in the first 15 months of life – 6 or more visits
- Well-child visits in the third, fourth, fifth, and sixth years of life
- Adolescent well-care visits
- Percentage of eligible beneficiaries ages 2-20 with at least one dental visit during the measurement year - visit must be with a dentist or dental hygienist
- Annual percentage of asthma patients ages 2-20 with one or more asthma-related emergency department visits
- Emergency department usage (excluding behavioral health and chemical dependency services) - age breakout of 0-19 is used
- Developmental screening in the first three years of life - a total of three age ranges for this measure are used
- Medication Management for People With Asthma – The percentage of patients with persistent asthma who were prescribed and remained on asthma controller medication for at least 75% of their treatment period - age breakout of 5-18 is used
- Hospital Readmissions – Total readmission rate within 30 days after discharge (behavioral and physical health) - age breakout of 0-20 is used
- Metabolic Monitoring for Children and Adolescents on Antipsychotics – The percentage of children and adolescents 1-17 years of age who had two or more antipsychotic prescriptions & had metabolic testing

### Adult Quality Measures

- Adults age 18-75 with a diagnosis of Type I or Type II diabetes who received at least one eye screening for diabetic retinal disease in a two year period
- Adults age 18-75 with a diagnosis of Type I or Type II diabetes who received at least one HbA1c screening during the measurement year
- Post-Admission Follow-up – The percentage of adults age 21-75 with an inpatient medical or behavioral health admission with a claim for post-admission follow-up with a physician, PA, or APRN within seven days of the inpatient discharge - medical admissions are defined as all admissions that are not maternity or surgery related
- Psychiatric Medication Management – The percentage of adults given a new psychiatric diagnoses, and medication, by a PCP who received a follow-up visit within 30 days
- Hospital Readmissions – Total readmission rate within 30 days after discharge (behavioral and physical health) - age breakout of 21-64 is used
- Emergency department usage (excluding behavioral health and chemical dependency services) - age breakout of 20 and above is used
- Medication Management for People With Asthma – Percentage of patients with persistent asthma who were prescribed and remained on asthma controller medication for at least 75% of their treatment period - age breakout of 19-64 is used

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
