RE: Temporary Deferment of Affordable Care Act Provider Enrollment Requirement for Residents Serving HUSKY Clients

The Affordable Care Act (ACA) requires that ordering, prescribing and referring (OPR) providers who render services to HUSKY clients be enrolled in the Connecticut Medical Assistance Program (CMAP). The Department of Social Services (DSS) has implemented claim edits that will deny any claim(s) when the ordering, prescribing or referring provider submitted on the claim is not enrolled in CMAP. DSS has temporarily deferred the implementation of the ordering, prescribing and referring (OPR) mandate for unlicensed interns/residents whose NPI is associated in NPPES to the primary taxonomy of 390200000X (Student/Resident).

The following EOB will post to pharmacy and compound claims as a warning only when the prescriber is an unlicensed intern/resident who is not enrolled in CMAP:

EOB 0237 “Submit with supervising NPI or enroll if licensed.”

The following EOB will post to non-pharmacy claims as a warning only when the ordering or referring provider is an unlicensed intern/resident who is not enrolled in CMAP:

EOB 1040 “Ordering/Referring provider is not enrolled on date of service”
